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P R E F A C E

The report on "Index Number of Industrial Production (Base 1970=100) 1995 to 1998" has been prepared on the basis of monthwise production data received from various selected industrial units in Rajasthan. This is the third attempt of its kind in the State.

The report contains monthwise and groupwise index numbers and monthwise production of Manufacturing, Mining & Electricity sectors for the period 1995 to 1998. Annual average and growth of different sectors have also been worked out and incorporated in this report. The report also highlights the methodology used for building up of these indices, allocation of weights and review of findings of the study. I hope this publication would be found useful by Planners, Policy makers, Research scholars and others interested in industrial development in the State.

I am grateful to the management of all concerned factories who extended their co-operation in providing data. I am happy to record my appreciation to the officers and the staff related to this report and also the computer staff in the Directorate for its dedicated efforts in coordinating the work and preparation of this report.

Suggestions for improvement in the report are most welcome.

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INDEX NUMBERS OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION IN RAJASTHAN (BASE YEAR 1970=100) 1995 TO 1998

1. INTRODUCTION:-

The Index of Industrial Production is an important indicator to measure over all picture of the growth of industrial economy. The industrial sector (registered & un - registered manufacturing) contributes about eleven percent of the State Income in Rajasthan. The Index number of Industrial production (IIP) aims at measuring changes in work done or quantum of output added in various sectors of industry.

2. BASE – YEAR:-

The year 1970 has been taken as the base year for the preparation of index number of Industrial production:

3. SCOPE & COVERAGE:-

- 3.1 The Indices of Industrial production for Rajasthan State cover production in Manufacturing, Mining & Electricity sectors. The scope of index in manufacturing sector is restricted up to factories registered under section 2 m(i) & section 2 m(ii) of Indian Factories Act, 1948 and functioning in the jurisdiction of the State of Rajasthan .
- 3.2 The indices are based on 67 individual items of production. Amongst these 67 items, 43 are covered in manufacturing, 23 in mining and 1 in electricity sector .

4. SELECTION OF ITEMS

4.1 MANUFACTURING SECTOR

4.11 SELECTION OF INDUSTRY GROUPS

The Industry Groups upto three digit level were taken into consideration for the selection of industries. On the basis of tabulation of Annual Survey of Industries 1970-71. The three digit Industry Groups were arranged in descending order of their value-added and a cut off point was made for the industry group, where the percentage of cumulative total of value-added to grand total comes out to 95 percent. By this procedure 13 industry groups came under selection. Which include among others Manufacture of Textiles, Printing & publishing and allied industries and Manufacturing of non metallic mineral product industries not else where classified have not been covered, because first two groups were of servicing nature and the third one relates with the hydrogenous units of measurement. To compensate the loss and to keep up the share of value added of covered industry groups above 90 percent of total value added, two industry groups viz. "Sugar factories and Refineries" and "Miscellaneous manufacturing industries not else where classified" were added to the industry groups finally selected .

4.12 Selection of items amongst three digit industry groups already elected

According to guide lines of CSO, all the items which formed at least 95 percent of the total value of production of the respective group were to be included in the index basket. If this criteria followed, many items in almost each selected industry group would have been chosen. Further, for each selected item, the number of factories was also large which was, practically not possible to ensure the regular flow of data from all such units.

As such, we restricted our approach to selecting those items for which the value of production individually formed at least five percent of total value of production of all items in the industry group, with this criteria 50 items were selected. However, the information relating to production of three items viz. M.S. section, Bangles and khandsari sugar was not covered. Three items viz. Railway wagon, Edible oil and crushed bone have been taken as separate items in the process of selection.

In this situation, the preparation of index number has to be restricted up to 43 items in manufacturing sector.

4.2 Mining Sector

In the Mining sector 23 items were selected on the basis of importance and availability of production data. For this purpose the mining sector was divided into following two

(1) Metallic Mineral

and (2) Non-Metallic Mineral

4.3 Electricity Sector

“Generation of Electricity” is the only item in this sector and the Rajasthan State Electricity Board has been treated as the single establishment.

5.

Weighting Diagram

5.1 The weights have been given to manufacturing, mining and electricity sectors in proportion of the value added by these sectors to the total value added in 1970-71 which comes to 73.25, 9.64 and 17.11 percent respectively.

5.2 Weights of the industry groups at three digit level of the above sectors have been distributed on the basis of the proportionate share of the value added of each industry groups to the total value added for all the selected industry groups taken together.

5.3 The industry group weights have been distributed amongst the selected items of that industry group on the basis of the proportionate share of value of production of each item to the total value of production of all selected items in that industry group.

6. Method of calculation

6.1 The index for each industry group/ sector and for the State as a whole have been calculated by using weighted arithmetic mean as under:-

6.2 Industry Group Level

Where, I_i = Index of production for i th industry.

P_{nij} = Current Month production of the j th item of i th industry.

P_{oij} = Average Monthly production of the j th item of i th industry.

W_{ij} = Weight assigned to the j th item of i th industry.

P, n, o and W denote production, current month, base month and weight respectively.

6.3 Sector Level

At the sector level the Index has been worked out by taking weighted arithmetic average of indices by using the following formula.

Where,

I_s = Sector level Index.

I_i = Index of i th industry.

W_i = weight assigned to the i th industry.

State Level

Where, I = Index of Industrial Production for the State as a whole.

I_s & w_s are Index Number and weight assigned to Sectors respectively.

7. Source of Data

- 7.1 The required data of production is obtained directly from the respective manufacturing units.
- 7.2 Source for Mining Sector data are Indian Bureau of Mines, Nagpur and Directorate of Mines & Geology, Udaipur.
- 7.3 Rajasthan State Electricity Board provides data relating to electricity generation, which includes electricity generated and the share of state in joint ventures with other states.

8. General Review:-

An analysis of the General Index of Industrial Production reveals that there is an increasing trend in the industrial production (except 1997) during the period 1995-98. The General Index of industrial production which was 634.27 in the year 1995 increased to 679.95 in the year 1998 registering an increase of 7.20% during the period 1995 to 98. The maximum increase of 12.48 % was observed in the year 1995 over the previous year 1994 and the minimum increase of 1.60% was observed in the year 1996 over the previous year 1995, where as it registered a decline of 1.12% was observed in 1997 over the previous year 1996.

Indices for three sub sectors viz Manufacturing, Mining, Electricity sectors are not in exact commensuration with the general index. Production under mining has increased at a faster rate (33.36%) as compared to the electricity- (20.55%), where as production under manufacturing has declined to (- 19.37%) in comparison to both the other sectors.

Under Manufacturing sector the index number stood at 321.03 in the year 1995 with an increase of 1.17% over the previous year 1994 where as this index continuously declined 6.86% in the year 1996, 5.93% in the year 1997 and 7.97% in the year 1998.

Index number of electricity sector on total availability base (Net Generation+ purchase) has shown an increasing trend. The maximum increase of 18.63% was observed in the year 1995 over the previous year 1994 and the minimum increase of 3.74% was observed in the year 1997 over the previous year 1996.

Under Mining sector, index number has declined by 8.91% during the year 1997 as compared to the previous year 1996. It, how ever, increased by 31.49% in the year 1998, 29.27% in the year 1995 and 11.34% in the 1996 over the previous years.

It is observed that index of Manufacturing sector has continuously declined from the year 1996 to 1998. This decline is due to the shortfall in the production by the production units affected by the poor demand of the production items in the market or curtailness of power. In the base year, 1970 (about 29 years before) some selected factories had been closed or did not function through out the year resulting in lesser production during the years 1996 to 1998. As per decisions taken by the Technical Advisory Committee, constituted by the Government of India and guidelines of Central Statistical Organisation, efforts are being made to change the base year and item basket on the basis of C.S.O. detailed ASI results 1993-94.
